- **Mission:** CMAC: To promote human-centered enhanced mobility through outreach, awareness, and professional development.

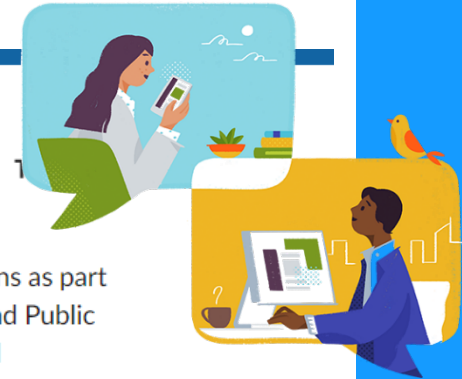

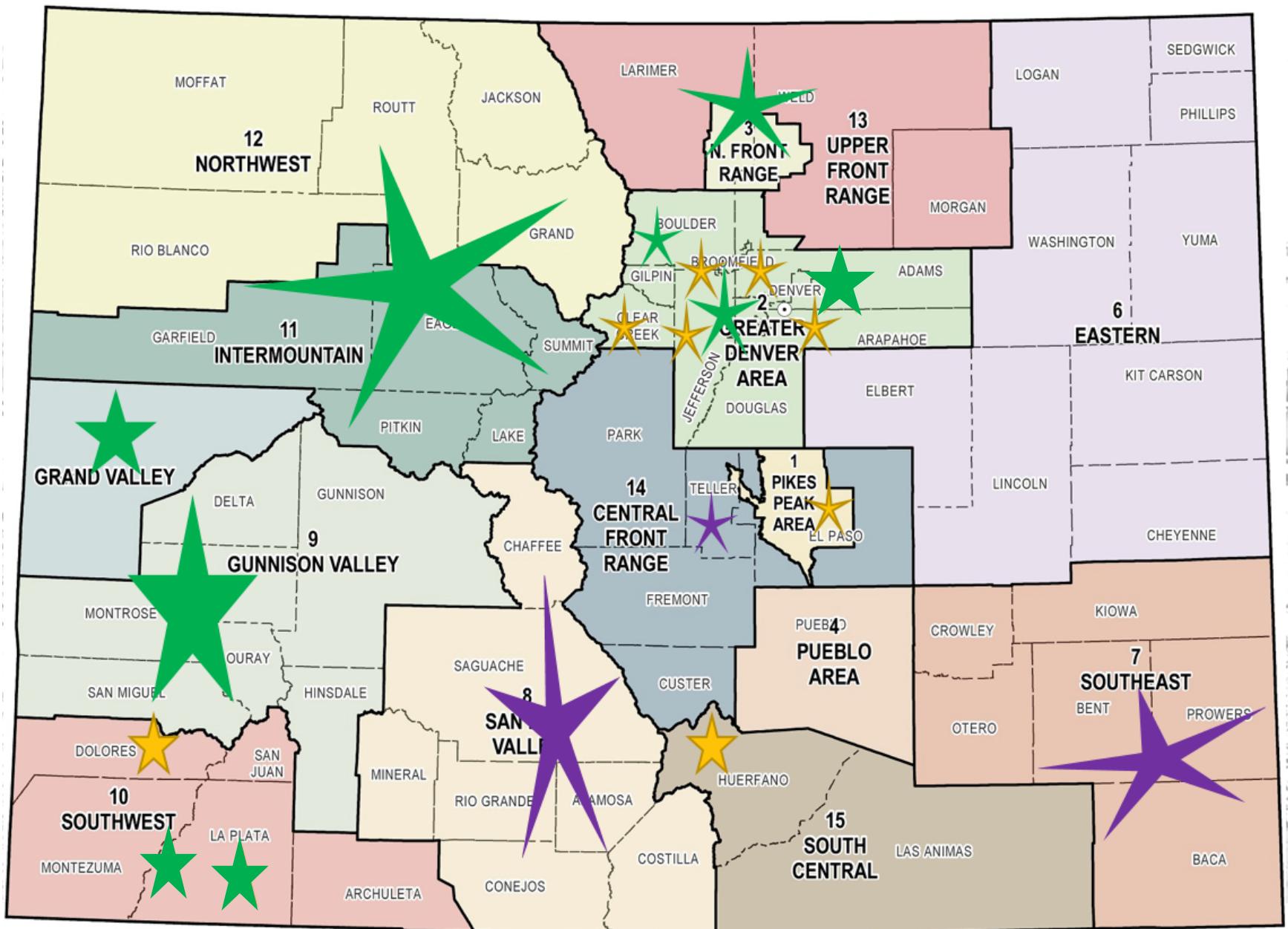
