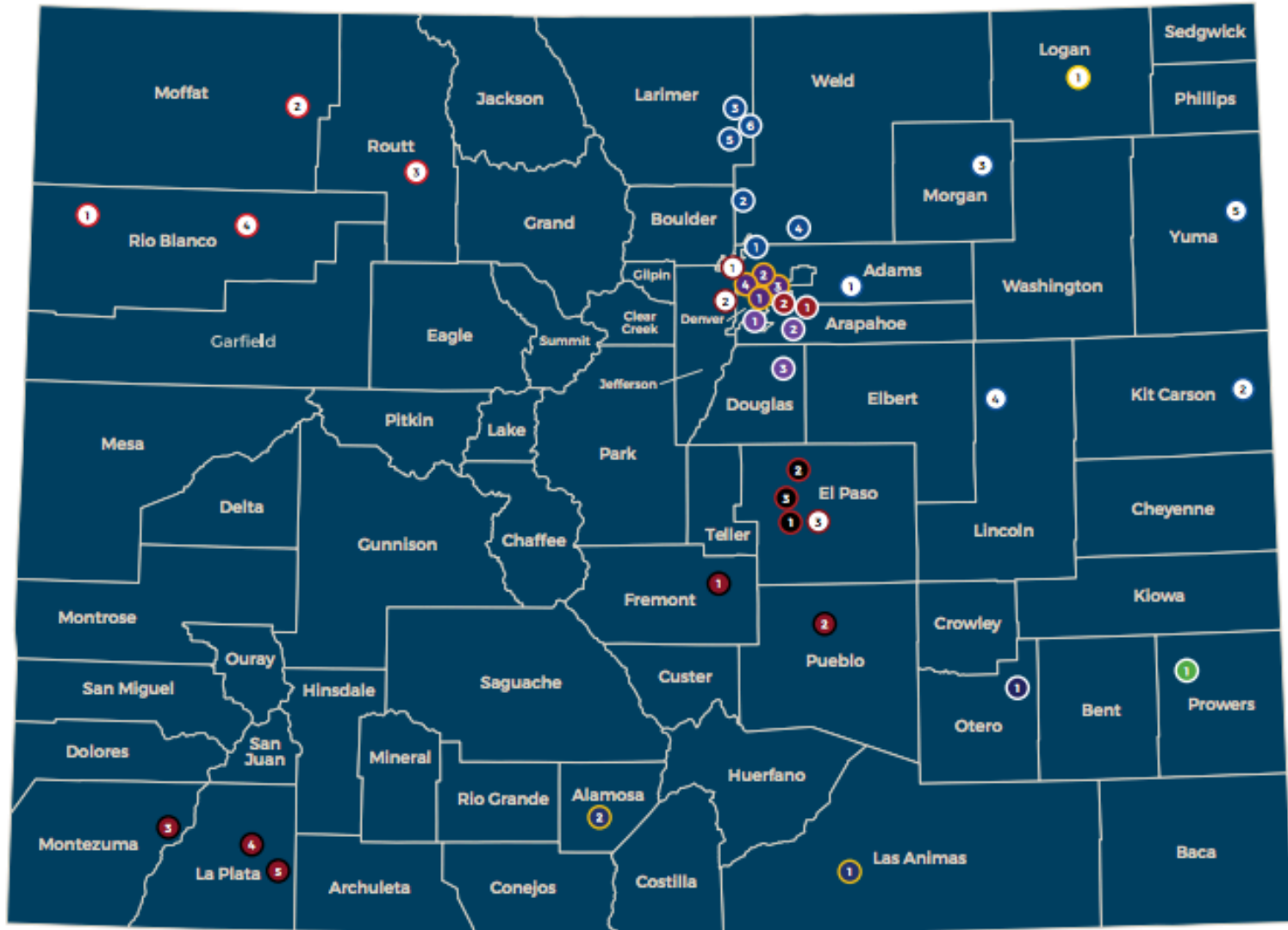

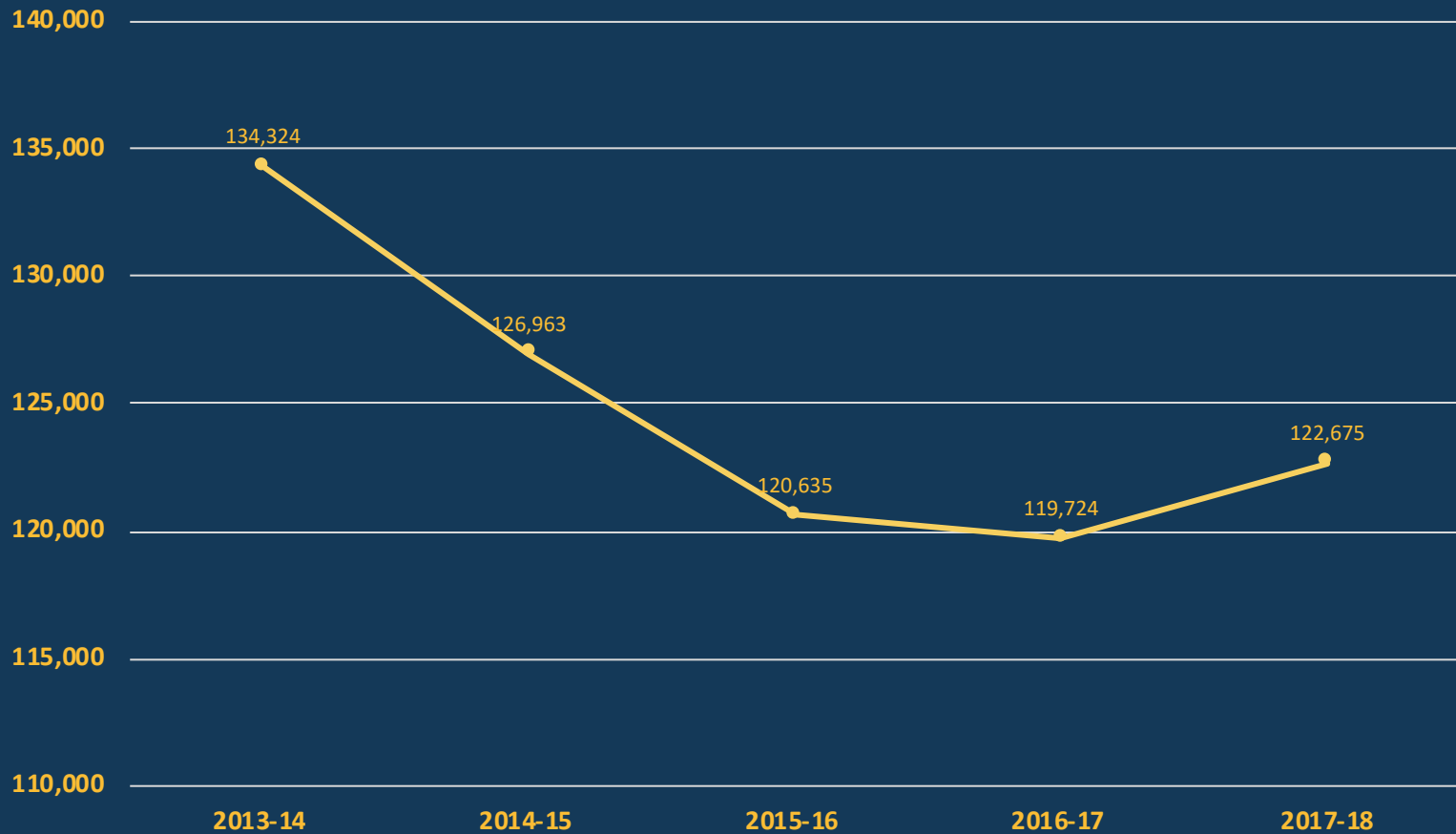


Student Enrollment

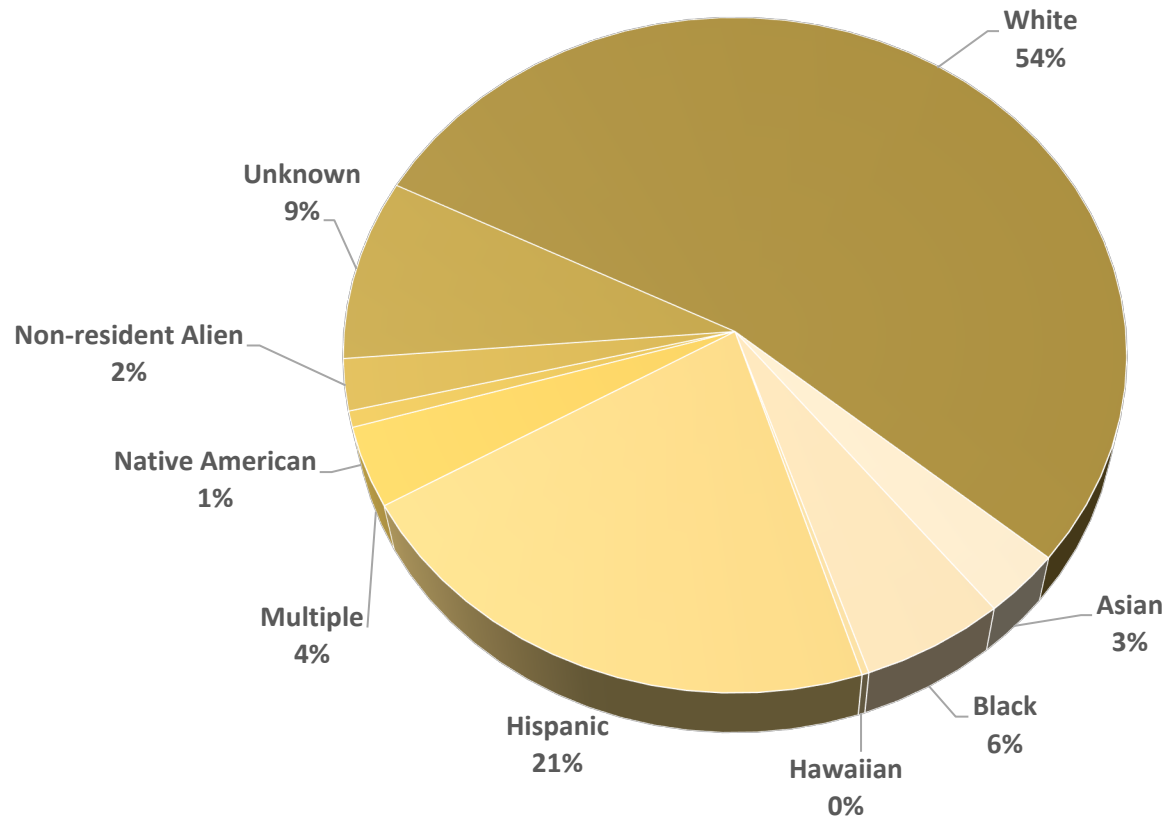
- 130,000 students annually

- 25,500 high school students through CE



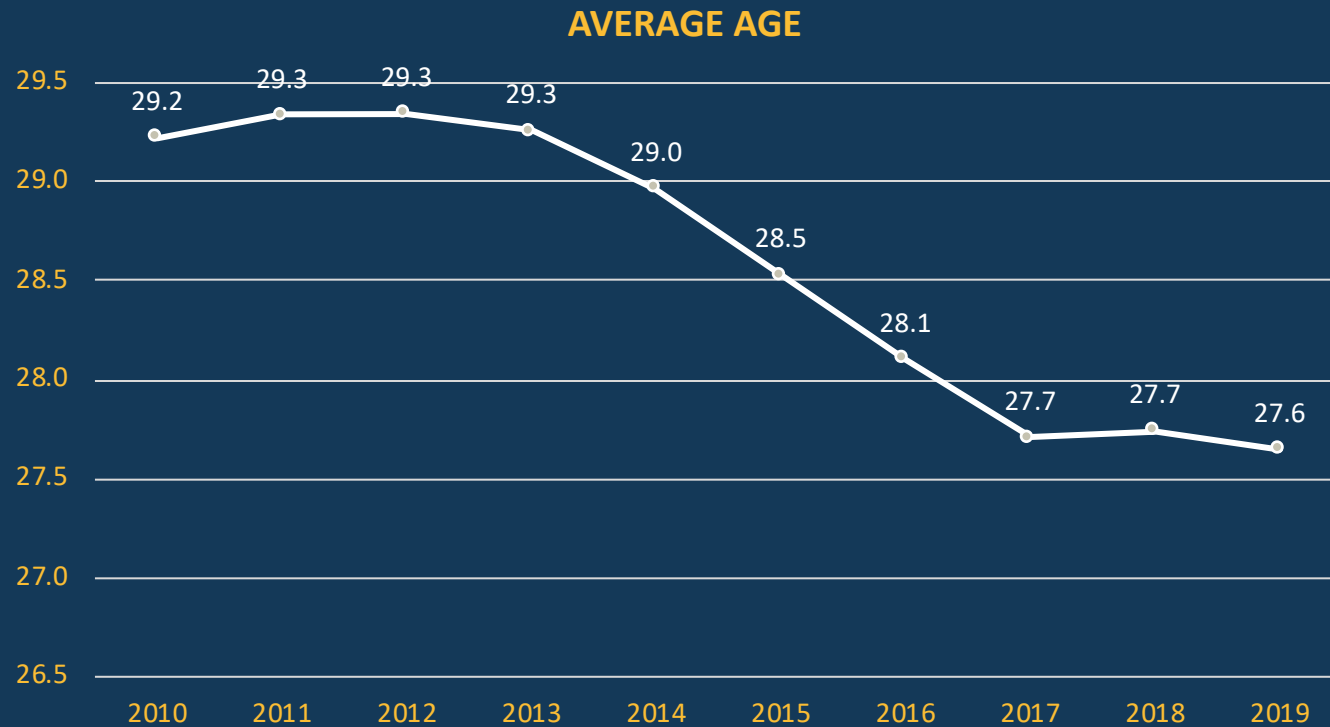
Enrollment - Headcount



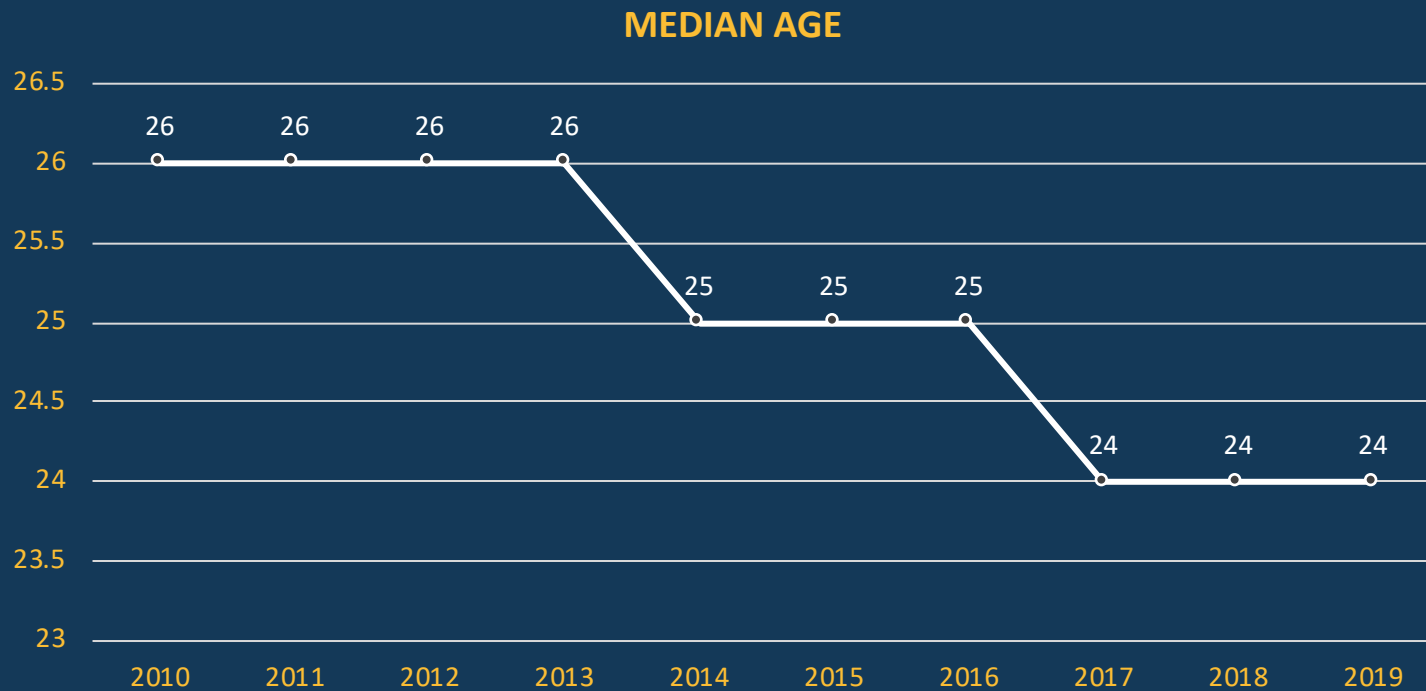
Enrollment – Students of Color



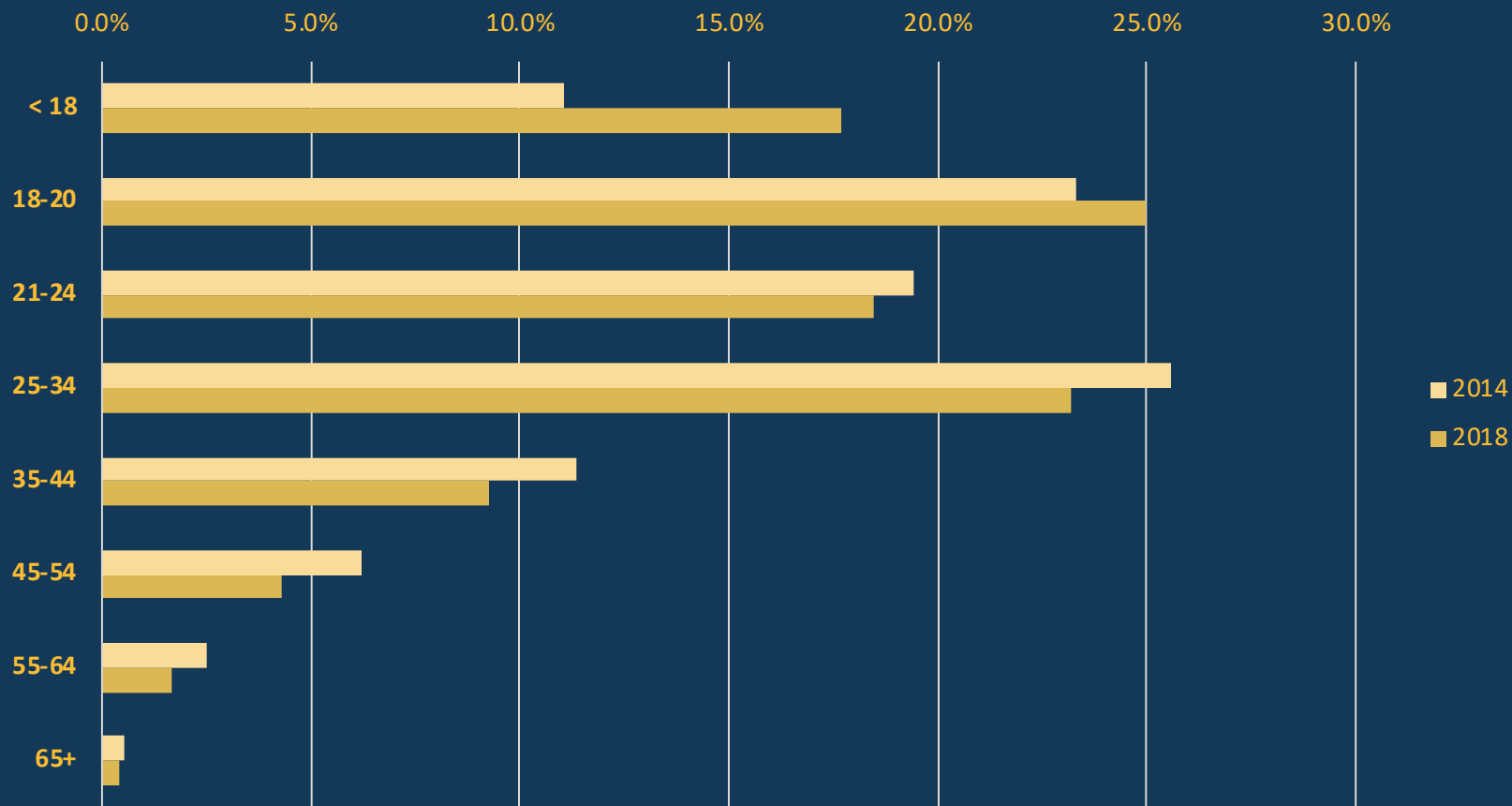
Average Age



Median Age

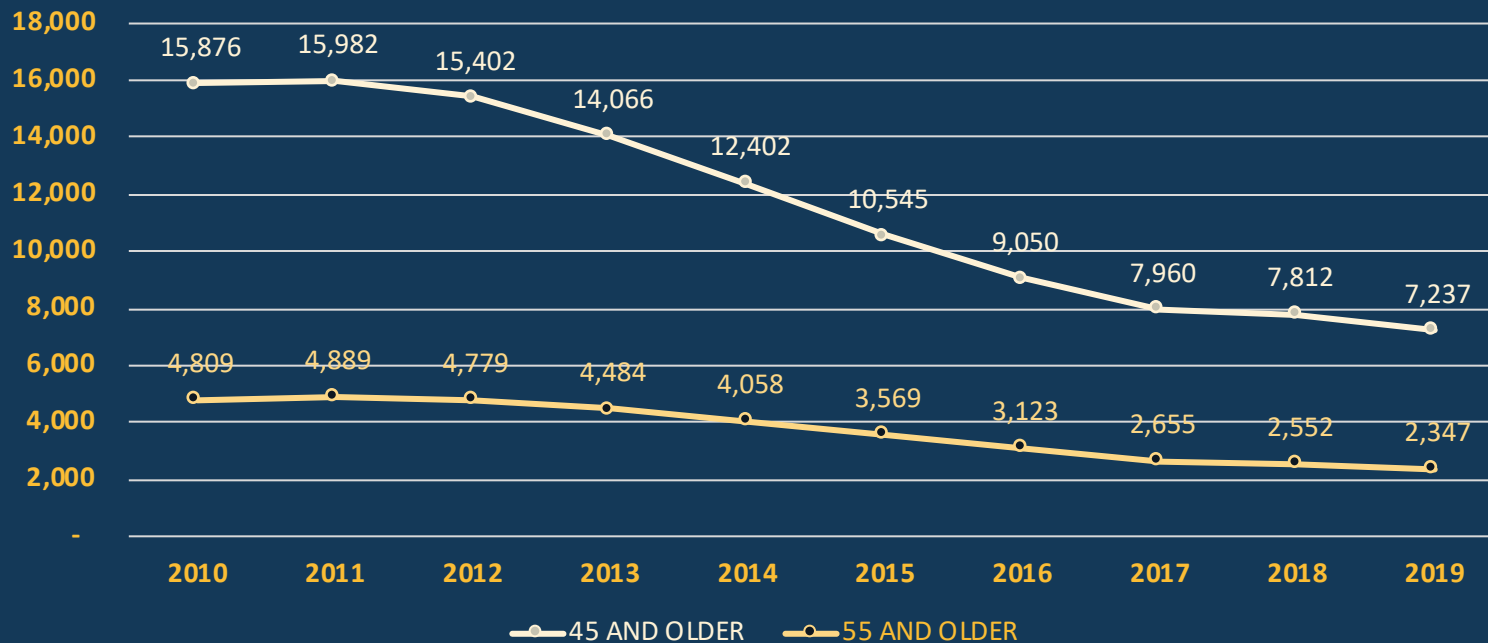


Age by Range



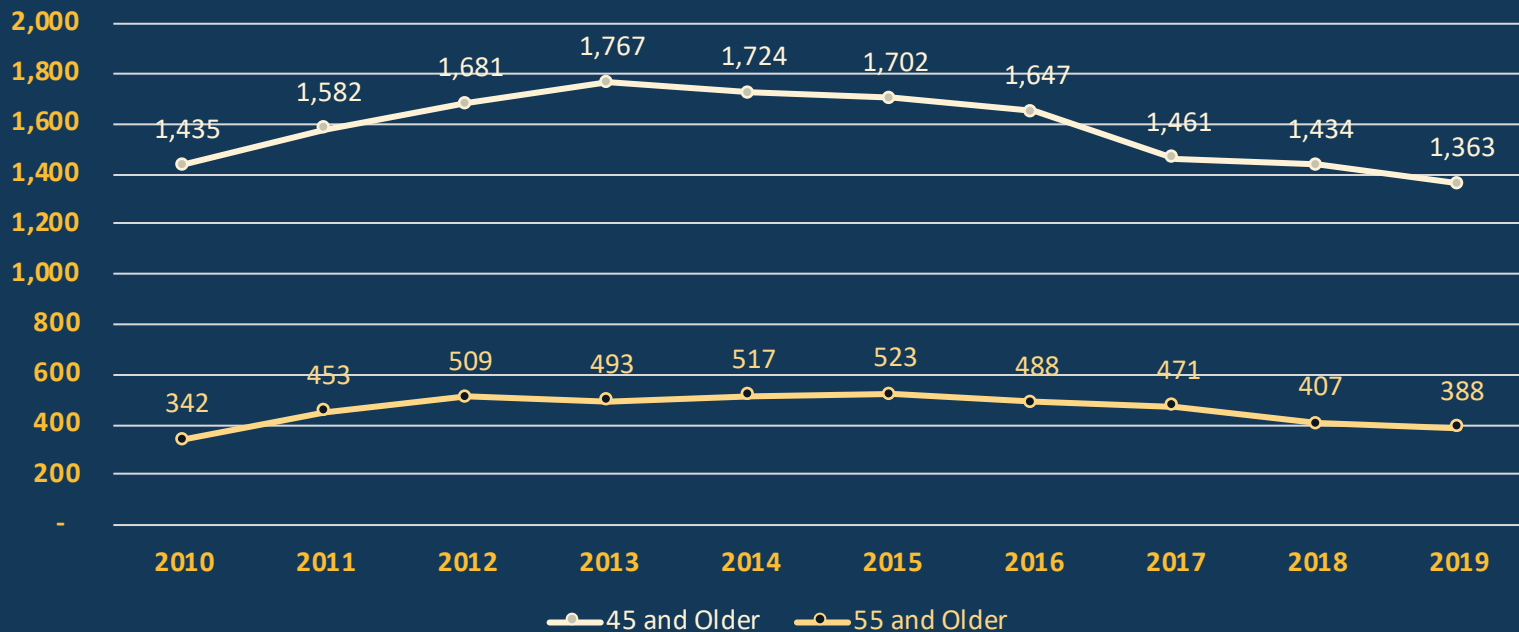
Enrolled – 45+ and 55+

Age 45+ and Age 55+



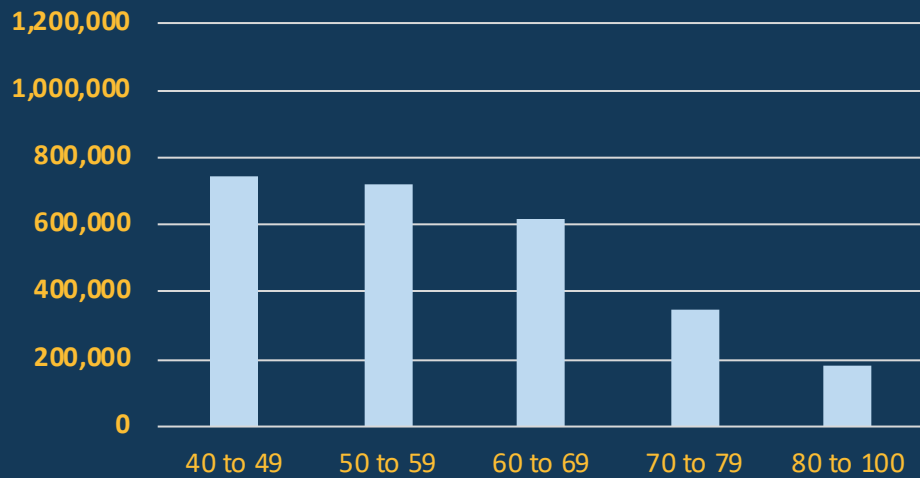
Graduates – 45+ and 55+

Students Age 45+ and 55+

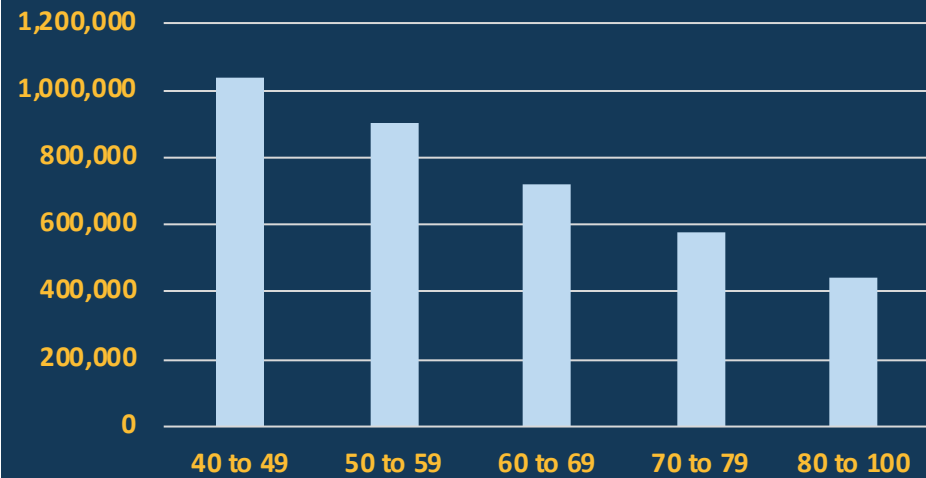


Population Projections

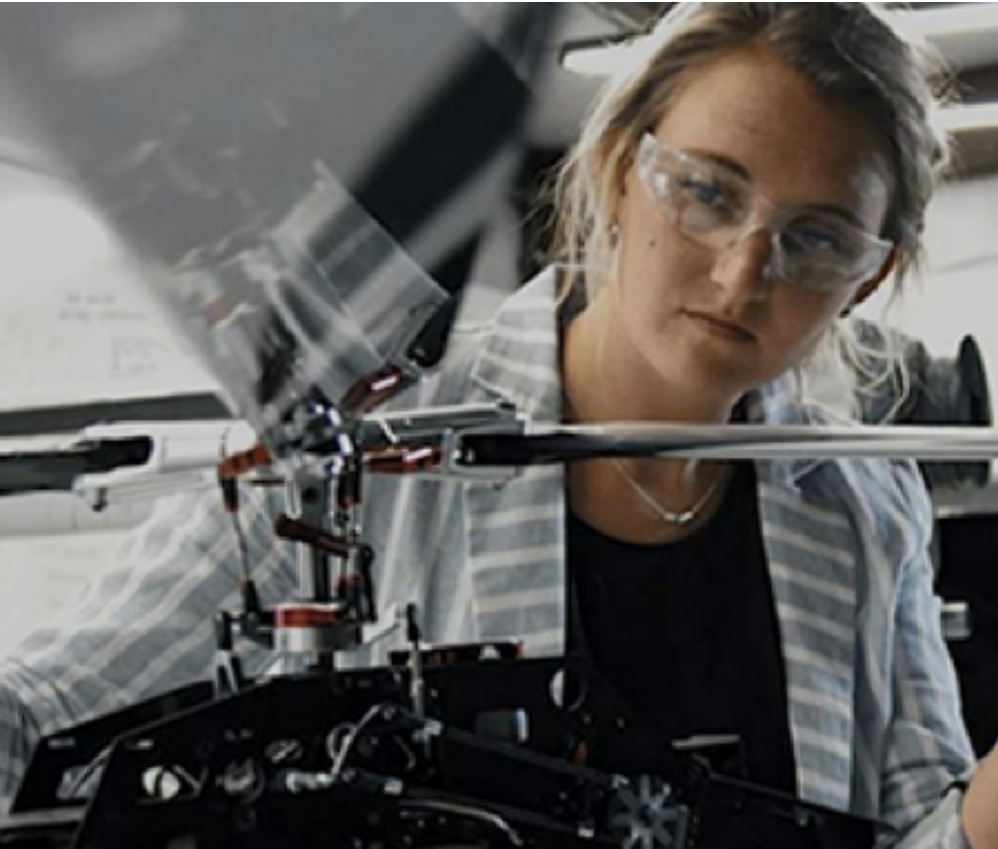

- 76% of graduates work in a field related to their CTE study

Customized Employer Training



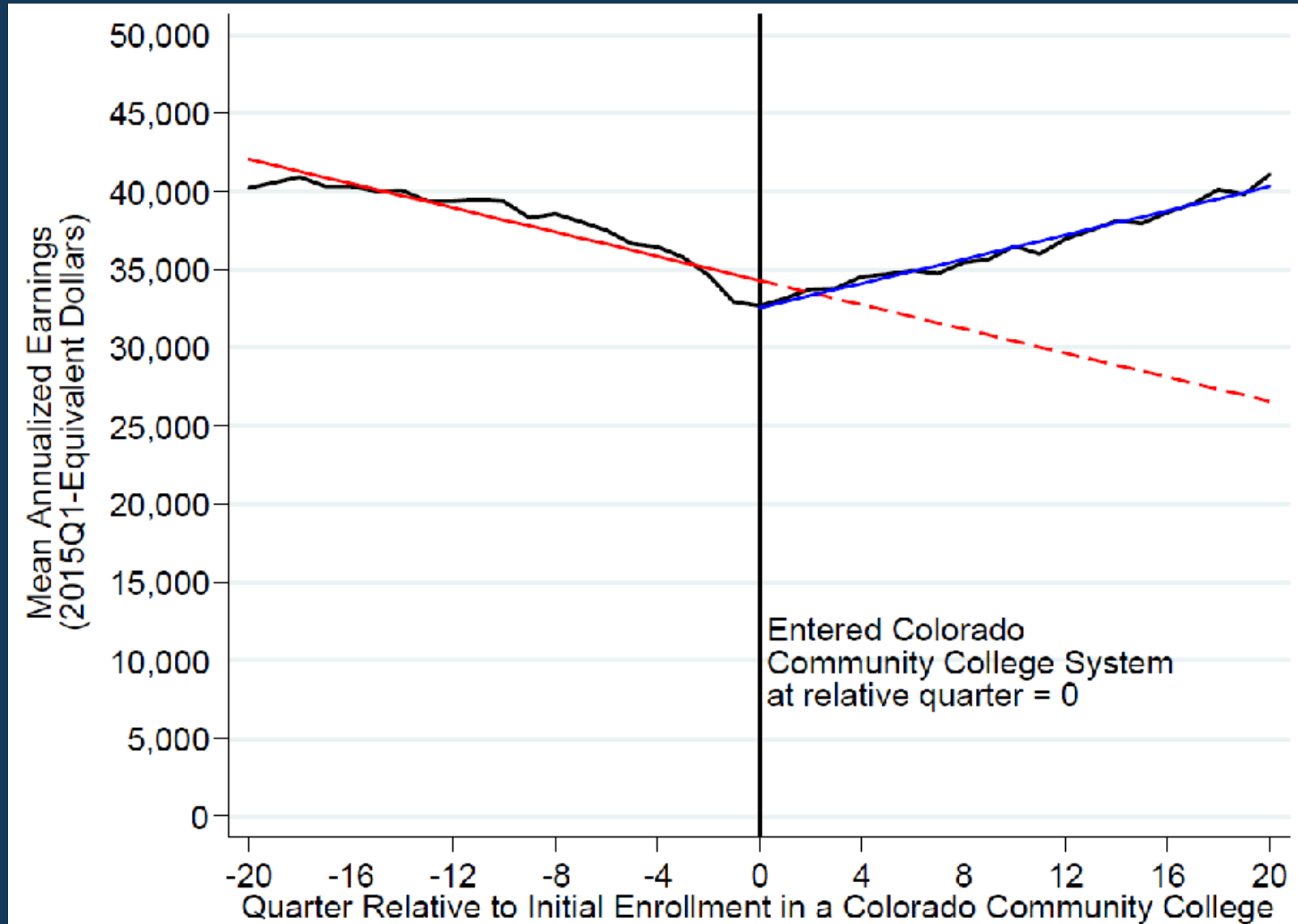
- 300 industry & community partnerships

Table 1: Prevalence of skills builders

Analytical Sample	Size
All students	258,915
Subset of CTE-focused students	74,997
Subset of skills builders	25,012
Skills builders as percentage of all students	9.7%
Skills builders as percentage of CTE-focused students	33.4%
