Example Actions

- Increased infection control surveys by 50%
 - Performed 1,198 surveys since March 2020
- Expanded the use of EM Resource to track and respond to critical PPE shortages
- Initiated a surveillance testing program in residential care settings
 - Distributed over 100,000 test kits to facilities across the state
- Launched the ConnectToCareJobs site to match job seekers with open long-term care positions
 - Currently have nearly 700 job seekers registered
