## Action Items:

- Josh Laipply to keep committee updated on mobility hub development (efforts to connect local transit with regional transit)

- Lisa Streisfeld to reach out to CDOT representative from Mobility Choice Blueprint
- Jarett Hughes to connect with Heather Kamper or Matt Helfant at DRCOG about VTCLI
- Jarett Hughes to connect with Amy Delpo, Administrator of Older Adult Services, Denver Public Libraries
- Jarett Hughes to follow-up on local navigation assistance/mobility ambassador programs

## Policy Idea Votes Tally:

- (0 votes) Support and expand older adult driving programs such as “Car Fit” and “Drive Smart”
- (4 votes) Create and support mobility ambassador programs to assist older adult in using public transit services
  - o Older adult programming at public library focusing on public transit options
- Support organizations and encourage family/friends in planning and discussing when an older adult may need to restrict or stop driving
- (2 votes) Regional transit providers should provide free public transit for adults 65+
- (0 votes) Explore ride share and carpooling incentives for transit network providers (e.g., Uber, Lyft)
- (4 votes) Encourage privately funded transit shuttles from age-targeted communities/residences to major shopping stores or shopping centers (e.g., King Soopers, Target, Walmart, Belmar)
  - o Perhaps a partnership between private business and city or county government
  - o Encourage circular routes for multiple shopping destinations (example Wheels2U in Norwalk, CT, find out what happened to Chariot pilot projects in Colorado; support for this especially when next funding cycles come out)
- (3 votes) SAPGA should engage with Mobility Choice Blueprint as a representative for older Coloradans
- (1 vote) Monitor and evaluate the DRCOG carpooling voucher program
