Via's On-Demand Pilot: Fulfilling Our Mission

- High cost of providing paratransit trips
- Current funding challenges
- We're operating at capacity while the need for our services is exploding
- The populations we serve want ondemand services



Goals for the On-Demand Pilot

- Significantly reduce the cost of a paratransit trip
- Double the number of paratransit trips using the current fleet
- Provide on-demand services
- Include the public on shared, ondemand trips to subsidize trip costs for older adults and people with disabilities

The Challenges of Providing Human Services Transportation Across the Country

- 1. Paratransit services are expensive, mostly because current operations are inefficient.
- 2. They're expensive even when human services providers are using industry-standard routing and scheduling software platforms.
- 3. As cancellations and no-shows occur, the current software requires a great deal of human intervention.
- 4. How can we make paratransit services more efficient? By increasing the average number of rides per hour.



The Pilot Project and Funding Challenges

- 1. STEP ONE: Take an optimization engine that turned a fixed-route service into an on-demand service and increased efficiency by 30% and ridership by 300%.
- 2. STEP TWO: Build out that optimization engine so that it can be used to provide on-demand paratransit services.
- 3. STEP THREE: Open the pilot to the public for last-and-first mile service.

FUNDING CHALLENGE: Nonprofits often don't have R&D funds.

SOLUTION: Employ a *cross-sector collaboration* to harness research-driven innovations in the private sector to economic, environmental, and social impact goals.
