Create a collaborative environment for addressing identified needs


We built a community of 50 individuals representing 30 agencies/organizations

Time frame: Nov. 2019 – Nov. 2021

- *24% older adults live alone vs. 9% overall population
- 57% of respondents live alone
 - Meal programs
 - Senior living
 - Senior centers





- Awareness of services





Key takeaways from survey...

- Significant need to make people aware of resources (social, transportation, supportive services)
 - Rely on local senior centers & local news papers
 - Paper, online and phone options all important
- Independent community
 - 73% drive themselves
 - Where to find, how to use and what is available are obstacles
- Housing supportive services needed
 - Handyman
 - Home modifications
 - Chore services
 - Person to help identify resources

 - Seniors Blue Book
 - 2-1-1
 - Housing Resource Guide
- Promote and educate community, providers, policy makers, leaders creating an older adults mindset
